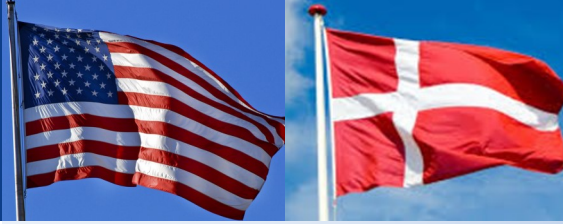


# Road to COP26
